In this position, the qualified candidate will be expected to handle a variety of roles within the Member Services department including:

- Provide support via phone and email for core services, including the World Handicap System,
 GHIN Admin Portal and App, and the Course Rating System
- Support and Training Member Clubs on the Golf Genius Tournament Management product suite
- Education seminars for Member Clubs
- Course Measuring in advance of scheduled USGA Course Ratings
- GAP Member Play Days, including both preparations leading up to events and on-site administration
- Monitor compliance and maintain records of Member Clubs, including an end-of-year Report Card summary of club performance
- Assistance in administration and scheduling of GAP Travel, including both domestic and international member trips
- Utilization of HubSpot to provide insights for membership programs and increase member engagement
- Other duties as assigned by the Director of Member Services
