- Field includes the exempt players entered and those who qualified at Open Championship Qualifying conducted at Jericho National Golf Club (June 19), Elkview Country Club (June 19), and Spring Ford Country Club (June 25).
- Format is 36-hole individual stroke play, two-day event. The low 60 scores and ties will advance to Day Two.

A year later, Braden Shattuck found himself in the same spot with the same shot. Standing on the 18th tee box of the 119th Philadelphia Open Thursday, the 28-year-old surged to the top of the scoreboard. Flashback to last July, at Philadelphia Cricket Club's Wissahickon Course, Shattuck was tied for the lead on 18. His closing tee ball flared to the right, however, and trickled out-of-bounds by four inches. A double bogey dropped him into a tie for second.

So with redemption on the mind, and 2-iron in-hand, Shattuck scripted a dreamy final scene in 2023. He stepped up, took a deep breath, and roped said 2-iron down the center of Lookaway's intimidating 18th hole. The Rolling Green Golf Club Director of Instruction then added some whip cream and strawberries with a decisive, and delicious, approach: a 7-iron from 166 yards to five feet.

Shattuck made birdie, instantly eliminating the Cricket nightmare.

The strong hitter played the Philadelphia's Open's 36 holes in 10 under, carding a final-round 66 to swoop past a field of the area's top amateur and professionals. His 10 under equaled the lowest score in relation to par. Rich Steinmetz set the mark in 2009 at Bent Creek Country Club. In addition to hoisting the John J. McDermott Trophy, presented to the champion, Shattuck earned the \$7,000 low professional prize.

"Of course it obviously felt great to get some redemption from last year since I completely messed that one up," said a smiling Shattuck. "I played well both days and just felt good to get it done.

"There's a lot of good names on that [John J. McDermott] trophy, and to be in that company feels great. It feels really nice to win this one."

The inaugural Open Championship featured a field of 23 players, three of which were amateurs. The entry fee was \$5. Jack Campbell of Huntingdon Valley Country Club won the event and collected the then \$75 purse. The format changed to match play a year later and reverted back to a 36-hole, one day stroke play event in 1909. GAP serves as the sole administrator of the Open Championship. It became a two-day, 36-hole tournament in 2017.
